



## Join the APG&E Customer Reward Program

### How To Join

Being a customer of APG&E comes with a lot of benefits these days. When you enroll, you lock in price-certainty for the term of your agreement, plus, you'll be automatically enrolled in our Customer Reward Program at no additional cost to you! Just provide your email address at enrollment so we can reach you to notify you of your upcoming rewards and we'll take care of the rest!

### Program Details

Customers who enroll in the APG&E Customer Reward Program will receive a \$25.00 electronic gift-card every four months, as long as the electricity account is active and flowing with APG&E. Once you make the switch to a rewards plan, you will receive your first customer reward gift card after your fourth bill from APG&E\* on the qualifying plan.

For example, if you become a rewards customer on January 25th when your meter is read, you will receive your first e-gift card after your fourth APG&E invoice around May 25th. Then, as long as you remain a customer of APG&E, you will continue to receive additional \$25.00 customer reward e-gift cards every four months!

But don't forget, you must complete all of the following to be eligible:

1. Provide an email address to allow for the communication of the reward program and electronic gift card delivery. You must keep that email address up to date with APG&E. If you opt-out of customer reward program emails, we won't be able to deliver your electronic gift cards.
2. Be an active customer of APG&E at the time of the customer reward.
3. Remain a customer of APG&E to keep earning rewards every four months!

\*Initial gift cards are paid out after four complete billing cycles with APG&E and will repeat every four months as long as the account remains active with APG&E. If a customer switches to another supplier, or if the account becomes inactive due to an outstanding balance with the utility, they forfeit their enrollment in the APG&E Reward Program.
